



Privacy Policy

The Forum of Executive Women (“FOEW” or “The Forum”) is committed and recognizes the need for protection and privacy issues in its operations and on the Internet. A member can visit The Forum’s public website without revealing any personally identifiable information. On the public website, The Forum does collect visitor’s IP addresses and domain names for site administration purposes, such as to analyze the data for trends and statistics. No personal information is obtained, other than the patterns of usage of various users, which may be tracked and monitored. The Forum also maintains a private database which stores specific background information about each member, as well as the member’s involvement in committees, attendance at programs, leadership duties, educational background, work history, home and office addresses and contact info, etc. Access to this domain is available only to members and can be accessed by a password protected login. Each member is only able to view her own information unless the member is also a member of either the current Forum Board or select committees. The Forum references this information to determine specific program offers, invitations and board opening opportunities that may be of interest to the member. The Forum does not make this information available to the outside public. The Forum may, however, share statistical or aggregated non-personal information about its members and users with media companies, strategic alliance partners, sponsors, and other third parties. This data may also be used to customize the Forum’s website content to better serve the Forum’s members and users.

I. Collecting Personal Identifiable Information

There are times when The Forum may collect personal information regarding its members and others, such as when such individuals are registering for a Forum event. The information that The Forum collects includes user’s name, home or work address, ethnicity and gender, and employer’s industry. Unless otherwise indicated, personal information, which is voluntarily provided, will only be used by The Forum.

II. Forum Member Mailing List Policy

The Forum prohibits the distribution or sale of its member mailing list, including contact information of e-mail addresses, phone numbers, and fax numbers. This prohibition includes the use of the member mailing list for the direct solicitation of FOEW members. The Forum maintains this policy to protect the privacy of its members and to avoid direct solicitation of FOEW members. The Forum may receive solicitation from vendors and sponsors and the Executive Director of the FOEW may disseminate the information to its members, as she deems appropriate.
