



NON-SOLICITATION POLICY

The Forum of Executive Women (“The Forum”) encourages its members to build relationships, to engage in professional networking and to collaborate with each other to fulfill The Forum’s mission of increasing the number of women in leadership roles, expanding their impact and influence, and positioning them to drive positive change in the region. In order to foster a professional and respectful environment for The Forum members and guests and to protect their privacy, The Forum adopted the following Non-Solicitation Policy.

1. Use of The Forum’s Membership Directory

The Forum’s membership directory is maintained to provide The Forum members with information about each other to help them further The Forum’s mission and implement its vision. The Forum’s membership directory shall not be used for any other purpose, including, without limitation, to market or otherwise promote a business or an organization to, or to solicit business or charitable contributions from, The Forum members.

For example, a member of The Forum shall not engage in or facilitate mass or targeted group mailings (including e-mails), phone calls or other communication campaigns using information set forth in The Forum’s membership directory for any purpose that does not further the mission and vision of The Forum. In addition, The Forum members shall not distribute The Forum’s membership directory or information set forth in such directory to any company or organization or any person who is not a member of The Forum.

2. Promotional Materials

The Forum members, guests and speakers at The Forum meetings, programs or other events shall not leave invitations, sales or promotional materials on meeting tables at such events or otherwise distribute promotional materials to Forum members unless otherwise stipulated as part of a sponsorship package or unless related to the topic of the speaker’s presentation, subject to the approval of the committee responsible for planning such Forum meeting, program or other event. Please see Section 1 above regarding restrictions on the use of The Forum’s membership directory in connection with the distribution of promotional materials.

3. General Information

The Forum members are expected to comply with this Non-Solicitation Policy, as well as to advise their guests at The Forum events, programs or other events of such policy *prior* to attending a Forum event.
